SEE THE FALL COLORS BY DAY AND CONTRA DANCE AT NIGHT

Take a drive from Denver to Chafee County and enjoy the beautiful fall foliage found around Cottonwood Pass and Monarch Pass. Make it a full day or even a weekend by stopping by the quaint town of Salida for the Saturday, Sept 20th Contra Dance at the Scout Hut. Also, you can visit Buena Vista for their fall Contra Dance on Friday, Sept. 12th, at the Congregational Church (217 Crossman St.) which may be early for peak fall color, but the Valley is beautiful any time of year.

Eleanor and Andrew Fahrney started the first Salida Contra dance as part of the newly formed Arkansas Valley Music and Dance (AVMAD). The Salida dance, co-sponsored by the Salida Rec Dept., is held at Scout Hut in Riverside Park every 3rd Saturday, September through May. The AVMAD also includes the Buena Vista contra dance group which holds dances every 2nd Friday of the month from September through May. The Buena Vista group is led by the original founders: John Vakarietis, Carol Barnes, & Randy Barnes.



AVMAD's board consists of five members. Board President Ron Chalian, a long-time dancer from the Denver area, who now enjoys retirement living in his high-altitude log house near Trout Creek Pass. Secretary Connie Wright, works as a seamstress in Buena Vista when she is not out hiking 14'ers, dancing, or selling calendars to support AVMAD. Treasurer Donna Rosentrater, works at the Adventure Unlimited Camp outside of Buena Vista, which is also the location for AVMAD's once-a-year dance festival *Stellar Days and Nights*. Susan Axe and Lee Dodge complete the AVMAD board. Susan works at Buena Vista Dental Care in Buena Vista when she is not in Denver playing with grandkids, and Lee spends time kayaking, skiing, biking, and dancing, and helps coordinate the Salida dances.
