Meet Elaina and Paul

Paul and Elaina moved to Colorado in January, leaving behind the Golden State. Along the way, they took in the Grand Canyon, arriving in Denver by way of Santa Fe – just in time to attend the Boulder dance that evening.

Elaina's parents were contra dancers and met dancing - Elaina likes to say that she began dancing "in utero". Her mother ran a local dance and Elaina began dancing on her own at the ripe old age of six. She's contra danced ever since, anywhere from three or four times a year to three or four times a week. Paul found contra through modern western square dance which led to folk dancing. He didn't contra dance regularly until several years later, after moving to the Bay Area.



Elaina has become involved with the new Hands Across series, helping with tear down and arranging picnics prior to the dance, weather permitting. Paul is also enthusiastic about the Hands Across series, having enjoyed Larks and Ravens dances in Northern California – his hope is that both new and experienced dancers will give Hands Across a try. In addition to enjoying the music and the dancing, Paul finds CFOOTMAD dances to be a great way to meet people in his new environs.

When not dancing, Elaina is a building energy researcher at NREL. She's involved herself in many other dance forms, both social and performing, including several sessions with the Denver Diamond Dolls, an all-female vintage dance troupe. Among her interests are board games and puzzles (check out Panda Magazine). As far as Colorado experiences, she's enjoying Clear Creek in Golden and the mountains. And with help from Paul, she's learning to enjoy cooking. When not on the dance floor, Paul enjoys bike riding, board games, and baking bread. He's also square dancing again, after a short hiatus.
